The National Museum of the Marine Corps is looking for a few good teen volunteers (age 16-18) to serve in our Teen Ambassador Program by becoming an Interactive Discovery Cart Presenter and Hospitality Ambassador.

Discovery cart presenters will develop hands-on presentations that are delivered in the galleries for visitors of all ages. This program allows visitors to try on a helmet, feel the weight of a pack or learn what Colonial Marines carried with them in 1775.

Teen Hospitality Ambassadors serve as a first face to the Museum. Working with adult Hospitality Ambassadors to greet and orient visitors.

Teen Ambassadors will receive 20 hours of classroom instruction and additional mentoring in presentation and hospitality services techniques. This is a great opportunity to develop public speaking skills.

We are seeking teens who can connect with our visitors; especially our young visitors. Those who successfully complete the training are asked to commit to one year of volunteer service at a minimum of eight hours per month.
