PME Topic:	Leadership through Scouting	Time Frame:	120 minutes
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Target Group(s):	All Scouting related groups	PME Style Recommended:	Individual Tour	Number of Participants:	60 maximum
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PME Objectives:	<p>The participants will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. examine different principles of scouting as they relate to the principles of Marine Corps leadership. 2. understand the relationship between scouting and the Marine Corps. 3. identify individual Marines that demonstrate the themes and principles of scouting. 4. show through Socratic discussion the importance of leadership and the need to develop personal leadership skills.
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PME Narrative:	<p>This PME aims to show the principles and themes of scouting and how they are demonstrated in the historical galleries of the museum. The participants will use various exercises in the galleries to learn the connection between scouting and the Marine Corps. The PME should include at least 15 minutes at the Iwo Jima flag. The tour docent may do that aspect of the tour or allow the Iwo Jima flag docent to conduct the training.</p>
