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PME Objectives:	<p>The participants will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Identify and understand the overall preparedness of the Marine Corps at the start of Vietnam through their available weapons. 2. Understand the changes in weapons technology during Vietnam. 3. Describe the significance of various weapons during specific battles of Vietnam. 4. Identify the concepts of warfighting and leadership as they apply specific tactics using specific weapons.
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PME Narrative:	<p>The goal of this PME is to examine in detail the weapons and tactics used by the Marine Corps during Vietnam. The students will also examine the lessons learned by the Marine Corps about weapons and technology during Vietnam. In addition, the students will become familiar with stories of heroic Marines during the Vietnam experience</p>
